One of these ways is to integrate in our team of trainers around the world, people who have already worked with us as volunteers. After we identified 370 of them in 2010, it was time to add new members to the family. We developed a system to select, train, and add to Harvest local teams – which are managed by 14 area coordinators – new members called **Associates** and **Partners**. **In 2012 we have become a family of 92 members!**
